The introduced genetic material does not cause the production of an infectious entity, produce a substance that is likely to be toxic to nontarget organisms, or produce a product intended for pharmaceutical or industrial use. 5. The introduced genetic sequences do not pose a significant risk of the creation of a new plant virus. 6. The crop has not been modified to contain certain genetic material from animal or human pathogens.
