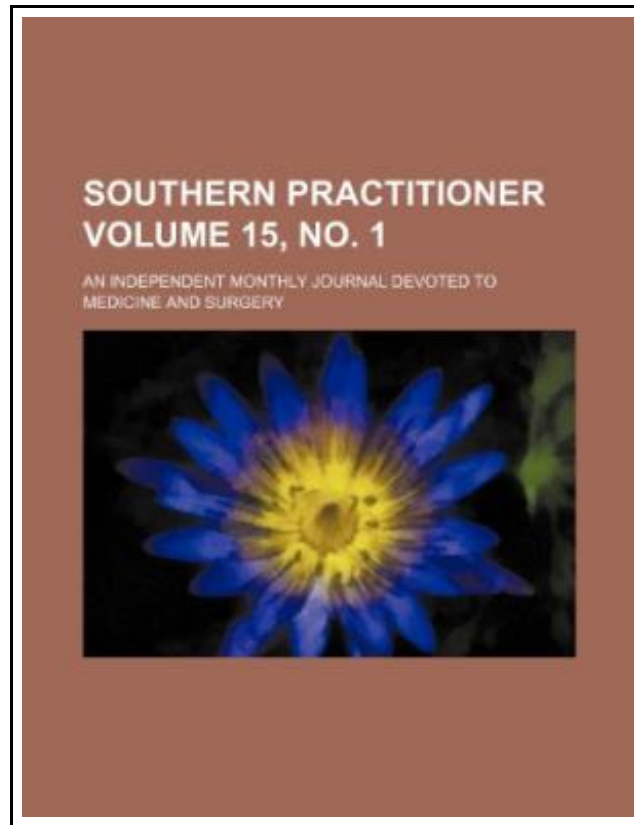

But I have repeatedly seen such operations end badly, reaction seeming to be checked, and all the symptoms aggravated from the beginning of etherization. Many years ago I became satisfied that the effect of the inhalation of ether affords a tolerably fair test of the propriety of operation. A few whiffs of it may be given, the pulse being carefully watched; if this gains in force and volume, and becomes slower, the other symptoms will probably decline also, and the administration can be continued until the patient is ready for operation. If the pulse flags or becomes irregular the ether should at once be withdrawn. --Jno. H. Packard, of Philadelphia, in Medical Standard.
